- 1500 business cards ordered in May, will be running out by August – will need to order more July or August

Literature “Racks”

These are the locations that now have our meeting lists, business cards, and some have Intro to NA Meetings IPs as well

- Wayne County Jail lobby, Ontario County Jail lobby, Seneca County Jail lobby, Yates County Jail lobby, Schuyler County Probation, Steuben County Public Defender’s office, Wayne Behavioral Health Lobby, ALL FLACRA Inpatient and Outpatient Lobbies (8 total locations), Seneca County Family Services, Seneca County Addictions
- Business cards are the highest demand item in the most recent restocking
- Will be updating FLACRA with 350 cards, 200 meeting lists for the inpatient/outpatient lobbies this week
- FLACRA requesting an additional 200 cards, 100 meeting lists, and a small literature rack of various IP’s for their new “Connections” center in Canandaigua

Other

- CASA in Dansville is requesting contact and literature – left a message, will try again soon
- Emails going out to city courts to see if they would like meeting lists and business cards
- Meeting with NYS OASAS in my role as NNY PR along with other members in NY NA – Meeting date pushed back to the end of August – awaiting confirmation.
- Will be discussing a New York State NA PR Ad-Hoc on the next NEZF PR virtual meeting this month. There seems to be reasonable support for moving forward with that. The Ad-Hoc would be a part of the North East Zonal Forum Public Relations group.
- Still need support at the committee level – not sure if people realize that Public Relations is supposed to be a committee or if it is assumed that I should be PR facilitator, website coordinator, phoneline coordinator, media coordinator and more. Always grateful to serve, but we could get much more done with willing members.
